It allows users to print from their desktops, laptops, and mobile devices. iPrint Appliance supports NetIQ eDirectory, Active Directory and Microsoft Identity as user identity sources. It scales to fit organizations of any size and provides a single solution to manage the printing needs across multiple locations.
